Remédiation 10: Pronoms Relatifs

Définition:

un petit mot qui renvoie à un nom (= antécédent) pour éviter de le répéter dans une même phrase. Il introduit une proposition relative, qui apporte une information supplémentaire à propos d'un nom.

WHO renvoie à une **personne**. (=qui, que)

Exemple: The president who abolished slavery in America was Abraham Lincoln.

WHICH renvoie à une **chose**. (=qui, que)

Exemple: The city which has the largest population also has the worst living conditions.

WHICH peut aussi reprendre toute une phrase; il sera alors traduit en français par "ce qui"

Exemple: There are too many people, which causes overcrowding. ATTENTION à l'orthographe!!! WHICH

THAT renvoie à une **personne** ou une **chose**. (=qui, que)

Exemple: This is an invention that will change global cities for the better.

WHERE renvoie à un lieu. (=où)

Exemple: The city where I was born has a lot of parks.

WHEN renvoie à un moment. (=où)

Exemple: I remember the day when Martin Luther King delivered his speech.

WHOSE renvoie à un **possesseur**. (=dont)

Exemple: Barack Obama, whose mother comes from Kansas, is an American-American.

Ø renvoie à une **personne** ou une **chose** complément. (=qui, que)

Exemple: The man Ø I showed you yesterday is the new mayor.
