

Remédiation 15 : expression de la volonté

Je veux + NOM :
Je veux + VERBE :
Je veux que quelqu'un + SUBJ :
Je voudrais :

I WANT	I WANT someone TO...	I WOULD LIKE (TO)	I WANT TO
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ATTENTION: **WILL** est souvent employé au lieu de **WANT** à cause de son sens **en allemand**
En anglais, **WILL** est un auxiliaire modal qui sert surtout à exprimer **l'avenir** (voir Remédiation 6)

Remarque: **WANT** est un verbe ordinaire qui **se conjugue** et se met à la **forme négative**

→ exemples: Elle veut devenir avocate. She **wants to** become a lawyer.
Il voulait aller à New York. He **wanted to** go to New York.
Ma mère ne veut pas que je devienne chanteur. My mother **doesn't want** me **to** become a singer.

Remarque: reprise elliptique (le verbe n'est pas mentionné car on le connaît déjà) :
on garde seulement le « TO »

→ exemple:

- Come with me !
- No, I don't **want to** (come) !
