ATTENTION :

En français on dit souvent « c'est » à propos d'une personne ; mais en anglais, on n'utilise jamais it's à propos d'une personne, seulement he ou she.

→ exemple : C'est un garçon sympa. = He is a nice boy.
C'est une jolie fille. = She is a beautiful girl.

Pronom personnel et déterminant possessif générique (qui remplace tout, pour une généralité) :

ONE / ONE'S

Il est l'équivalent de son/sa/ses générique en français.

→ exemple : Having **one's** own house is a common feature of the American Dream.
Avoir **sa** propre maison est trait commun du Rêve Américain.

SOMEBODY, EVERYBODY, NOBODY, ANYBODY :

- s'accordent au singulier

- mais sont repris par le pronom et le déterminant possessif 3^{ème} personne du pluriel (they, them, their)

→ exemple : **Nobody** says hello when you meet **them**.

→ exemple : **Nobody** knows **their** neighbours.
